1.1 Overview of the Municipal Corporation/ Municipality/NAC

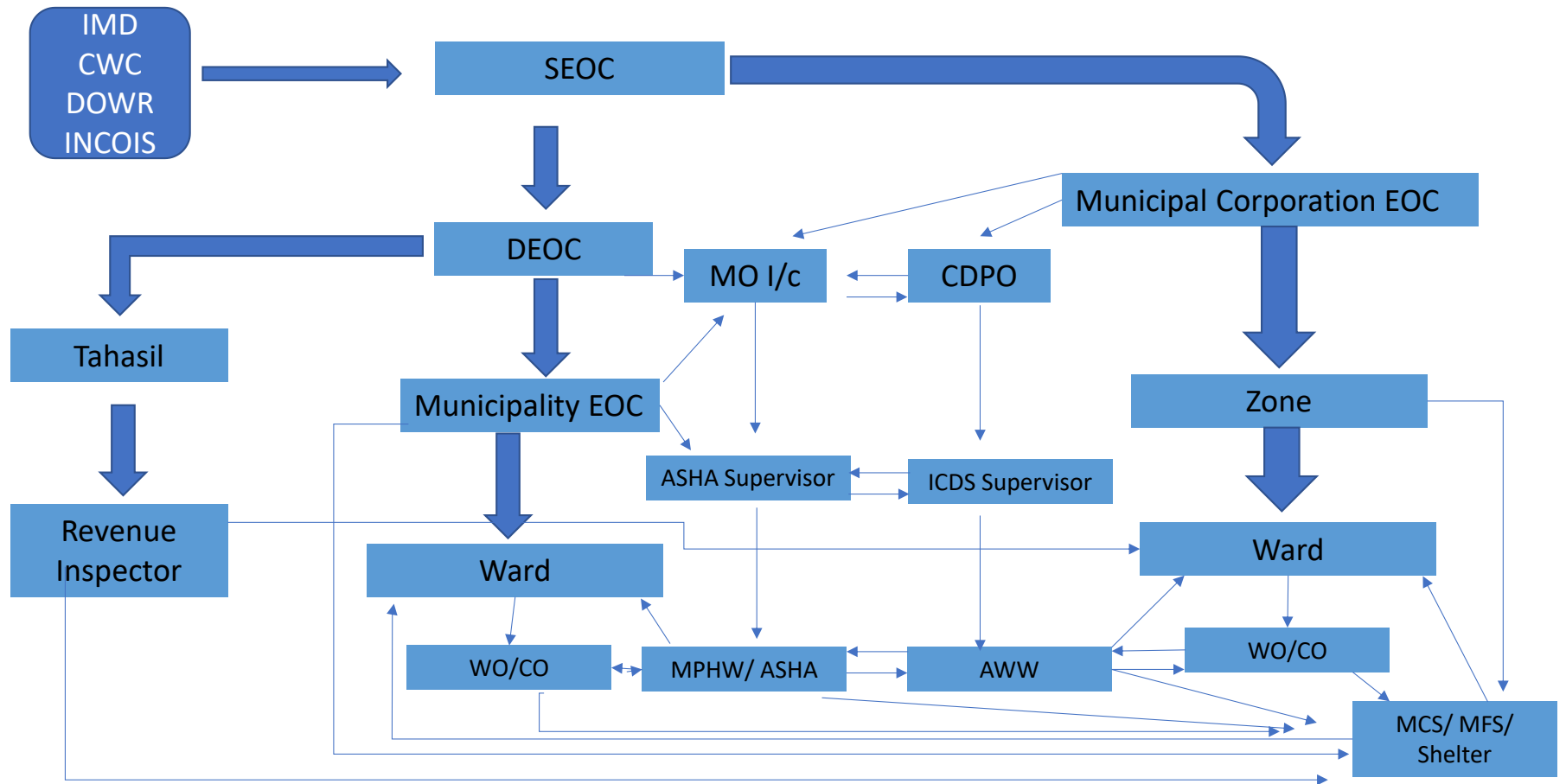
